Each team shall have minimum 2 players. A-B against X-Y and a double. A third player can play in the double.

Sanctions: Ängby International will be played on maximum 26 Stiga tables, all with a blue surface. Barriers will be placed out minimum 10x5m around each table. Fixed times and table numbers to all matches will be printed in the tournament program.

Training camp: There will be a training camp in Stockholm in Vällingbyhallen Monday-Wednesday before the tournament. Please contact Mikael Frank by mail for more information.

Limitations:

Players (**TAKING PART IN SOCC**) are also allowed to participate in one event on Saturday and one event on Sunday in the Ängby international.

Players (**NOT TAKING PART IN SOCC**) are allowed to participate in one event on Friday, two events on Saturday and one event on Sunday in the Ängby international.

In Men´s Singles the maximum number of entrances in the qualification round is 96 players and **8-16 players** will be directly qualified to final knock-out stage and will play their first match on Saturday.

In Women´s Singles the maximum number of entrances in the qualification round is 64 players and **8-16 players** will be directly qualified to Saturday´s final knock-out stage.

The final knock-out rounds in Men´s Singles will be played on Saturday.

If the numbers of players are high we might need to play one round for non seeded players on Friday evening. The final knock-out rounds in women´s single will be played on Saturday.

Entries:

Players date of birth has to be given in the entry form. Players shall be listed in order of playing level.

The organizing club has the right to enter four “wild card” players in each event in Ängby international.

Girls are not allowed to participate in the boys' events.

Seeding:

Seeding will be set up by the World, European and Swedish rankings and in cooperation with the Swedish Table Tennis Association.

Draw:

The draws for knock-out events will be made in the Ängby office on Thursday 3rd November.

The draws for the group events will be made after check-in at the playing venue (**one hour before start**) on the day of competition.

Warm-up area: A practice hall with nine tables will be available during the tournament.
